Workshop Participation Agreement

I hereby acknowledge I have voluntarily applied to participate in dog training activities with Pacific Northwest Portuguese Water Dog Club. I am aware there are inherent risks and hazards involved with and around dogs, and I am voluntarily participating in the activities with the knowledge of these potential dangers. I am not relying on Pacific Northwest Portuguese Water Dog Club to prevent such occurrences. In order to participate in Pacific Northwest Portuguese Water Dog Club workshop classes, or other related activities, I, BEING FULLY INFORMED OF SUCH RISKS AND HAZARDS, AGREE TO ASSUME ALL RISK OF SUCH OCCURRENCE.

Hold-harmless: I/we agree to hold the PWDCA and PNWPWDC, their members, directors, officers, agents, instructors at this event, the owner and/or lessor of the premises, any provider of services for this event and any employees or volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or illness which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person, animal or thing by the act of my dog while in or upon the trial grounds or while entering or leaving same, and I/we further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, disappearance or theft of, or damage injury or illness to, my dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury or illness is caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any other parties aforementioned, by the negligence of any other person, or by any other cause or causes.

Indemnification: I/we hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this water workshop, howsoever such same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Arbitration: Notwithstanding any of the above, in the event I/we or my dog(s) suffer any damage, injury, illness, or loss (including the death of the dog(s) arising from the water workshop), I/we agree any claim arising out of or related to the entry, exhibition or attendance at the event or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this agreement shall be settled by arbitration pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association. I/we agree any such arbitration will take place at the workshop site within 60 days of the incident giving rise to the claim, or at such other time and place as the parties may agree. I/we agree to pay a prorated share of the costs of any such arbitration.

The workshop site is located within the confines of Deep Lake, Nolte State Park. It shall be everyone's responsibility to become familiar with and adhere to all park rules and regulations including but not limited to the following:

- Dogs must be on leash or confined to a crate or exercise pen in a manner is not disruptive at all times, except when participating in warm-up sessions or when actually being trained.
- You are responsible for picking up after yourself and your dogs. Please keep the park clean of litter and dog waste.
- No alcoholic beverages will be allowed at the workshop site.

I have carefully read this release of liability and fully understand the contents thereof. I am aware this is a release of liability and a contract between Pacific Northwest Portuguese Water Dog Club and me and I agree to it of my own free will.

I/we agree these clubs have the right to refuse this entry or any entry for any cause which they deem to be sufficient.

I hereby certify I am the actual owner of the dog or duly authorized handler for the actual owner of the dog whose name is entered above. I have read and agree to be bound by the agreement printed on the other side of this entry form as well as the stipulations contained in the workshop information, plus any directive received from any official involved in staging the event. I certify and represent the dog entered is over 6 months of age (at the time of the event) and is not a hazard to persons or other dogs.
