Remember \$10 credit card/cash (**exact change**) for parking each day! Or buy an annual pass for \$30. Parking is included with a camping fee.

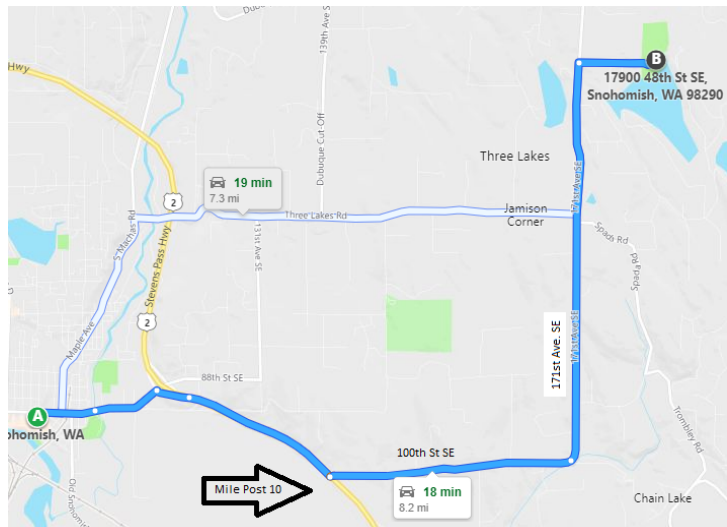
From I-5

Take the Snohomish/Wenatchee exit (exit 194) onto US Highway 2 (off I-5 in Everett). Take a left onto 100 St SE (Westwick Rd) at milepost #10. Just past 167th Ave, the road bears sharply to the left (north) and becomes 171st Ave SE. Continue on 171 Ave SE to 48th St. SE; turn right onto 48th St. SE. Park entrance is at the end of the road. Follow the road down to the water, there will be parking near the picnic shelters, look for lots of PWDs!

From I-405

Take the State Highway 522 East exit (exit 23) towards Monroe/Wenatchee. Hwy 522 dead ends in Monroe at the junction of US Highway 2.

Take US Highway 2 West towards Snohomish/ Everett. Heading west, take a right onto 100 St SE (Westwick Rd) at milepost #10. Continue from Step #3 above.

If entries are low, practice sessions will be scheduled for Friday in lieu of trial. Equipment check-in will be available on Thursday during site setup. You may check in your equipment at that time for the weekend.

Notice to Participants

The trial will be held in accordance with the most current provisions as set by the PWDCA Water Trial Manual and any updates. Each participant is responsible for familiarizing themselves with said regulations. Copies of the Water Trial Manual may be downloaded from www.pwdca.org.

Eligibility: PWDCA sanctioned water trials are open only to purebred Portuguese Water Dogs registered with the AKC or foreign registry or with AKC PAL/ILP (Purebred Alternate Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege) numbers. On the day of the water trial(s), the dog must be eligible to compete in events sanctioned by the Kennel Club in which the dog is registered (AKC, CKC). Additionally, on the day of the water trial(s), the handler of the entered dog must also be in good standing and able to compete in events sanctioned by the Kennel club in which the dog is registered. A dog must be at least six months of age on the day of the trial to enter the Junior Water Dog level and one year of age to enter the Apprentice level and above, unless the dog has successfully passed the Junior level. All dogs must be in good health and in proper condition for the test level in which they are entered. The minimum age for water trial participants is 9 years old. Participants between the ages of 9 and 18 must have a parent or legal guardian present at the site while they participate. Neither a judge nor any member of his/her immediate family or household nor any dog owned by a judge or any such family or household member shall be eligible to compete at a trial where the judge is officiating or performing an observer or provisional judging assignment. "Competing" shall include acting as a substitute steward. A dog may enter the Apprentice Water Dog titling level without having a Junior Water Dog Certificate if it is at least 12 months of age on the day of the trial (or as outlined in the first paragraph of this section). A dog must have earned an Apprentice Water Dog title in order to be eligible to enter the Working Water Dog level. A dog must have earned a Working Water Dog title (Working Water Dog Excellent is an optional title and is not required) to be eligible to enter the Courier Water Dog level. A dog must have earned a Courier Water Dog Excellent title to be eligible to enter the Master level. **All dogs will be limited to one entry per day, with a 2-day maximum.**

Move-ups: Before trial closing, eligible dogs may be moved up to a higher test level by the owner through their PerfDog account. Any move-up requests after closing but before the trial must be sent as an email request to the trial secretary. To move up or move down during the trial weekend, the secretary must be notified by the end of the day before the change. For inclusion in the catalog, move-ups must be received no later than the closing date, Friday August 19, 2022.

Acceptance of Entries: The host club has the right to refuse any entry for any cause which they deem to be sufficient.

Entry Priority: Priority will be given to Junior through Master **Regular** entries until the lottery deadline on Friday August 5, 2022 11:59 PM PDT. A team is considered a "Regular entry" if (1) the dog has not earned a title at the titling test level entered before the trial date, or (2) enters at the Junior Water Dog level and has not earned a certificate or title before the trial date. A team is considered a Non-Regular or "exhibition" entry if (1) the dog has earned a title/certificate at the level entered more than 30 days before the trial date, or (2) a dog has earned a title before the trial date, and is entered at the Junior Water Dog level. Also Non-Regular entries include (3) entries received after the closing date including day-of-trial entries and (4) day-of-trial move-ups and (5) any other entries which do not qualify as Regular entries. Non-Regular ("exhibition") entrants may enter any level up to and including the dog's highest titling level. Both regular and exhibition entrants may qualify and receive awards at the Water Trial. A dog with WWD title will be a Regular entry if working toward the WWDX title, and a dog with CWD title will be a Regular entry if working toward the CWDX title.

Non-Regular ("Exhibition") entries will be accepted only if the trial does not fill by the lottery deadline. After the lottery deadline, all entries will be accepted on a space-available basis in the order received.

Entering Your Dog: A dog may be entered in **no more than 2 days** of the 3 available days. When you are confirmed for any spots, then you must go to Perfdog.com and pay for the spots within 3 days (72 hours) to hold them. If not paid, then those spots will be offered to the next dog on the Waitlist. If you are on the Waitlist, and get offered a spot on a certain day, you may either accept or decline that spot, within a 3 day (72 hour) window of time. If you decline, then you *may* receive another offered spot, but that is not guaranteed. We anticipate that Saturday will be very popular, so it may be an advantage to choose Friday and/or Sunday.

Entry Lottery and Wait List: All Regular entries received during the lottery draw period ending Friday August 5 at 11:59 PDT will be treated equally. If Regular entry limits are exceeded by that date, a random drawing from all Regular entries received will be held at a location designated by the Trial Secretary. Remaining entries, if any, will be drawn for a position on the wait list. All entries received after August 5, and up to the closing date, will be accepted on a first-come basis if the trial has not been filled, or will be added to the wait list if the trial is full. The wait list will be used to fill openings as they become available prior to the trial date and for day-of entries.

Day of Trial Entries: If entry limits are not reached by the closing date, day of trial entries may be accepted at the Judge's discretion with an additional fee of \$10.00 per entry, and as time is available and conditions permit. You may contact the Trial Secretary in advance to check on the possibility of Day of Trial entry availability.

Day of Trial Move Ups: Move ups will be accepted as time permits with an additional \$10.00 per entry. All move ups will be tested at the end of their class or the end of the day (depending on the order of judging), but prior to Bitches in Season. *Entrants who qualify one day and want to change their class level for the next day may do so at no additional charge, but must notify the trial secretary before the close of the day prior to the class change.*

Closing Date: ACCEPTABLE ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE CLOSING DATE, 11:59 p.m. (PDT) on Wednesday August 19, 2022. After this time entries may not be accepted, canceled or substituted. **All entries MUST be made through PerfDog.** Entries may NOT be hand delivered, faxed, or telephoned.

Refunds: No refunds of entry fees will be made after the closing date. Fees for entries include a \$3 Processing Fee. Entries may be canceled or changed online prior to close of entry. Refunds (less the \$3 Processing Fee per entry) may be either kept as a PerfDog credit, refunded to credit card, or mailed via check (less a \$3 Check Fee). Entries may be canceled online after close of entry, but no refunds will be given.

Late Fees: If time and space allow, entries will be accepted after closing. An additional \$10 late fee must be paid for all entries after closing, including Day of Trial Entries. All late entries and Day of Trial Entries must be completed through perfdog.com. No paper entries will be accepted on site.

Running Order and Judging Program: After the Closing Date, a judging program containing the days' event schedules, the day(s) that each test level will be offered and the order of judging of teams will be emailed to each entrant with the final entry confirmation.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season will be exhibited **at the end of the day**. The owner or handler of such a bitch must notify the on-site trial secretary of the bitch's condition before the start of the trial, and **before** bringing the bitch onto the trial grounds. **Bitches in season shall not be brought to the test area or the surrounding area until their handlers are instructed to do so by a judge or judge's designee. Acceptable locations for crating bitches in season will be limited strictly to those areas designated by trial officials, or in the entrant's car.**

Substitute Stewards: A handler may substitute an individual of his/her choice to perform functions otherwise assigned to a steward during that handler's test. Such an individual is referred to as a "substitute steward." It is expected that the substitute steward be capable of performing the duties required of that position (ex. throwing a dummy the distance needed for an exercise). A handler is allowed the use of one substitute steward when competing at the Courier and Master Water Dog level. The use of a substitute steward is allowed for the Timed Swim at the Junior or Apprentice levels. For all other exercises at any level, the use of a substitute steward must be approved by the judge and the Trial Chair, prior to the briefing and for extenuating circumstances. A substitute steward should be named in the handler's official

entry form or, at the discretion of the judge and/or Trial Secretary, may be approved on the day of the trial no later than the end of the judge's briefing for the test level in which the handler is competing. In either case, the substitute steward must sign an official entry form acknowledging the "hold harmless" agreement before he/she will be allowed to participate in the handler's test.

Equipment: Exhibitors may use their own equipment if approved after inspection by the judge or judge's designee unless the exercise requires the use of club equipment. Equipment will be available from the Host Committee.

PFD and Footwear: Any person working a dog in or near the water and any substitute steward must wear closed-toe footwear and a USCG-approved life vest.

Site Rules and Conditions: Dogs must be on leash or confined to crates at all times except when participating in a warm-up session or being judged. Participants are responsible for picking up after their dogs.

What to bring: Your own food, snacks, and drinks, canopy if desired, crate or exercise pen, chairs, USCG approved life vest (mandatory), appropriate protective footwear (mandatory), towels, sunscreen, foul weather gear, trial equipment, leash, water dish, dog food, poop scoop bags, etc. Restrooms and water are available.

Rights: All rights to televise, tape, advertise, photograph, promote, or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the host clubs or their assignees. By attending the event, all persons in attendance grant permission (without need of any further consent) for the use of their and their animals' likenesses and voices in any resultant product.

We expect this trial to fill quickly. It will be unlikely that late entries, day-of-trial entries, or move-ups will be possible. So it will pay to enter early (before August 5) to be sure you get into the Lottery. All entrants will be accepted and placed on the waitlist, with no money paid at that time. Once you are informed that you have a spot in the trial(s), you will have 3 days (72 hours) to go online at Pefdog.com and submit payment to complete your entry.
